

A WOODEN CLEAT ALTERNATIVE

GENERAL BRIEF:

ALL B&N WALL PANELS ARE DESIGNED TO BE MOUNTED TO ONSITE WALLS WITH EITHER ALUMINUM Z-CLIPS OR WOODEN FRENCH CLEATS.

IN ORDER TO KEEP THE PANEL AS FLUSH TO THE WALL AS POSSIBLE, B&N TYPICALLY SUPPLIES 0.25 THICK ALUMINUM Z-CLIPS WITH ALL PANELS. THIS KEEPS PANELS CLOSE TO THE FINISHED WALL, AND ALLOWS FOR EASY REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF PANELS IF NECESSARY.

SHOULD ONSITE CONDITIONS DICTATE THE NEED FOR A THICKER CLEAT, B&N RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING STEPS WHEN USING CONTRACTOR SUPPLIED WOODEN (ALSO KNOWN AS FRENCH) CLEATS.

- -OUTSIDE CONTRACTOR TO FABRICATE WOOD CLEATS, B&N DOES NOT SUPPLY. CLEATS TO BE CUT IN TYPICAL 45° PROFILE AS SHOWN IN (FIGURE 1)
- -WHEN EVALUATING WALL CONDITIONS, BE MINDFUL OF WALL CLEAT ANCHOR LOCATIONS. THE USE OF BLOCKING OR FIR STRIPS IS ADVISABLE.
- -ALL B&N PANELS WILL SHIP WITH CLEAT MOUNTING HOLES AND PLASTIC ANCHORS INSERTED IN SEVERAL ROWS ON BACKSIDE OF PANEL.
- -PANEL MOUNTED CLEATS TO BE 2.0 INCHES NARROWER THEN THE PANEL IS WIDE, ALLOWING FOR PANEL TO EXTEND BEYOND CLEATS. FIGURE 2
- -SHOULD MULTIPLE PANELS BE MOUNTED SIDE BY SIDE, IT IS ADVISABLE TO HAVE CLEATS STAGGER WITH THE JOINT LINES BETWEEN PANELS. SEE (FIGURE 3)
- -IF FACE ALIGNMENT IS AN ISSUE, SIDEWALLS OF PANELS CAN BE CUT IN THE FIELD TO ACCEPT BEECHWOOD BISCUITS.
- -VERTICAL ABUTTING EDGES CAN BE CUT WITH HANDHELD BISCUIT JOINTER. TYPICALLY IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO USE GLUE ON BISCUITS.
